



## "A Walk in the Wild" Todgarh Raoli Wildlife Sanctuary"





This is the TodgarhRaoli Wildlife Sanctuary home to leopards and well known for its sloth bears and grey jungle fowls.























## Government, the Village People & Ecopanions

- Walk the Wilds is a unique program that brings together 3 participants the Government, the Public and the Private Enterprise in a collaborative effort.
- To make the local people main beneficiary of wildlife tourism the Department of
  Forests, Government of Rajasthan, constructed a pair of Eco Lodges in 2007 that were
  to be managed by the villagers of Dudhalia. Later in 2008, two Swiss Tents were also
  added. But the idea had many limitations. In October 2010, Ecopanions began to help
  the resident people to manage these facilities on a daily basis as well as bring clientele
  from urban centres.
- Ecopanions would like a creative partnership with the villagers of Dudhalia & the forest dept. Your taking this Program will go a long way in empowering the local people and help make a dream come true.
